



Matriculation Fee (All Campuses)

Students are assessed a Matriculation Fee each semester based on their enrollment (per credit hour) for the semester. The Matriculation Fee covers costs for resources and services provided to all students at Langston University regardless of location. Those resources and services include: Assessment, Academic Records, Security, Career Services, Counseling, Student Technology, Library Automation, and Library Resources.

Urban Campus Fee (Urban Campuses Only)

Students attending the Urban Campuses are assessed the Urban Campus Fee which contributes to the overall support of Urban Campus operations, administrative functions, and instruction costs.

Activity & Facility Fee (All Campuses)

Students are assessed the Activity & Facility Fee each semester based on their enrollment (per credit hour) for the semester. The activities and facilities fee is used to support debt service of constructed and/or renovated facilities, facility operations, student support services, athletics, and other student activities.

Publication, Health, Cultural & Recreation Fee (Publication Fee Only, Urban Campuses)

The purpose of this fee is to enhance the quality of student life by partially offsetting costs for health staff and facilities, support for the student newspaper, as well as some cultural and recreational activities. Students attending an Urban Campus are assessed only the publication portion of the fee and do not pay for health, cultural, and recreational activities through this fee.

Distance Learning Fee (All Campuses)

The Distance Learning Fee is assessed only to students who are completing coursework online, or who enroll in hybrid courses which are taught online with a face-to-face component. The fee is used to enhance online course delivery to all campuses.

Classroom Improvement Fee (All Campuses)

Students are assessed a Classroom Improvement Fee at \$10 per course for all traditional, face-to-face courses. The fee is used to fund improvements to all academic buildings including deferred maintenance, HVAC maintenance and replacement, security improvements, and boiler units.

Wellness Fee

The fee for students at the Langston campus is \$95 per semester to support select wellness activities and the funding for construction and maintenance of the Student Recreation Center which will be built on the Langston Campus. Students at the urban campuses will not be assessed a fee but could purchase a membership. The Student Recreation Center will be equipped with exercise rooms, cardio area, weights, suites, meeting rooms, a clinic and offices.
