



AGE

Anyone age five (5) and over must possess a valid ticket for entry inot the W. E. Anderson Stadium.

ALCOHOL

Alcoholic beverages are neither sold nor permitted on campus and on stadium grounds.

BACKPACKS

Bags larger than 14"x14"x6" are not allowed. Diaper bags and medical bags are permitted. All bags are subject to search.

CAMERAS

For your enjoyment, Langston University permits still cameras without a flash as long as the lens is less than 4 inches in length. Any commercial photography is prohibited without the express consent of Langston University. Video cameras are not permitted in the stadium unless authorized by Langston University.

CLEAR BAY POLICY

To provide a safer environment and significantly expedite fan entry, Langston University Athletics' clear bag policy limits the size and type of bags that may be brought to Langston University sporting events. Fans are limited to one bag per person with a small clutch bag for privacy (see images at the end of these rules for more information).

CONCESSIONS

Concessions are operated by Elior Food Services inside the stadium. Cash and major credit cards are accepted. No outside food or beverages are permitted inside W. E. Anderson Stadium.

DRONE USAGE

Drone use, unless approved by the Langston University Department of Athletics and Office of Public Relations, is strictly prohibited during all homecoming events, including the football game.

EJECTION

The Langston University Department of Athletics reserves the right to eject any person whose behavior is in violation of these stadium rules, the fan code of conduct, or illegal in nature. Tickets will be collected from the violator(s) without refund and they will be escorted from the stadium.

EMERGENCIES

In case of emergency, dial 911. You can contact Langston University Police at (405) 466-3366.

FAN CODE OF CONDUCT

Langston University desires to provide an atmosphere conductive at enjoying athletic and hosted events. Cosequently, we ask that you refrain from the following:

- Interfering with the progress of the event
- · Smoking Including electronic cegarettes
- Foul, obscene, or abusive language or actions
- Fighting, unruly or inconsiderate behavior
- Conduct that endangers fans or participants
- Intoxication

FIRST AID

Persons requiring first aid or emergency help should contact event staff or security personnel.

GATES OPEN

All stadium entrances will open at noon (12:00 p.m.) on October 11, 2025.

HEALTH & SAFETY

By entering the stadium grounds, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to diseases such as the flu, COVID-19 and others.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following items are prohibited on the football field and track:

- Gum
- Seeds
- Sugared Drinks
- Food
- Tobacco Products
- Alcohol
- All pets
- Roller Blades
- Skates

- Steel Cleats
- High heel shoes
- Strollers
- Bicycles
- Hover Boards
- Skateboards
- Motorized Vehicles
- Unsupervised Children
- Drones

SERVICE ANIMALS

Animals or pets of any kind are prohibited in W. E. Anderson Stadium with the exception of service animals and service animals in training for guests with disabilities. Service animals are welcome inside the stadium but not on the field, and must remain on a leash or in a harness at all times. Service animals will rest in the seating area of the individual with a disability, rather than in the aisle. A guest whose service animal poses a threat to the safety of other W. E. Anderson Stadium guests and employees may be asked to escort the animal off the premises.

STROLLERS

Any and all strollers are prohibited.

RE-ENTRY

No re-entry is allowed into the stadium.

RESTROOMS

Restrooms are located in the stadium and near the Tennis Courts for major events.

SECURITY

- Uncooperative patrons showing disregard for other patrons, the stadium of the teams may be ejected from the facility.
- Ticket holders are responsible for their conduct as well as the conduct of their guests and/or person using the tickets
- Spectators are reminded that they are prohibited from entering onto the field before, during and after the game unless they are properly credentialed or accompanied by an authorized staff member. Violators are subject to arrest.
- You and your belongings may be searched upon entry.
- Suspicious activity, disruptive patrons and guest related problems should be reported to a staff member or police officer immediately.

TICKET INFORMATION

- General admissions tickets can be purchased online at langstonsports.com or at the ticket booths. Ticket booths open two hours before kickoff (at noon, or 12:00 p.m.).
- Adult General Admission tickets can be purchased for \$30.00.
- Visiting Student Tickets can be purchased for \$15.00.
- Children five (5) and under are free.

STUDENT TICKETS

- There will be a designated student gate entrance located in the middle section of the stadium.
- Students must reserve their free ticket online using the Home-Town Ticketing platform located at langstonsports.com. Click on the TICKET tab and then select the appropriate game. Your student ID# is needed to reserve your free ticket online. Print or screenshot your ticket QR code. This code will be screened at the entry gates.

FACULTY/STAFF TICKETS

Langston University faculty and staff should use the Home-town ticketing platform located at langstonsports.com to download their season tickets. Click on the TICKET tab and then select the faculty/staff season ticket option. Faculty and staff will need your Langston University ID# or CWID# to retrieve your All-Sports Season Ticket. Be prepared to show your ID and Digital Season Ticket at all home games.

UMBRELLAS AND TENTS

Umbrellas and tents are not permitted within the stadium.

WEAPONS

Weapons are prohibited unless allowed by law. No open carry of firearms is permitted on campus.

WEATHER EMERGENCIES

Please stay weather aware during all campus events. Please check local news outlets and follow @LangstonU on X (formerly Twitter) for information related to weather and weather delays. Weather emergencies and directions will be broadcast over the stadium public address system if occuring during a campus event.



Clear Bag Policy




CLEAR TOTE

Plastic, vinyl or PVC No larger than 12" x 6" x 12"




CLEAR DRAWSTRING BAG
