Frequently Asked Questions

What is Lion Camp?

- Lion Camp is an immersion experience to make our first time entering freshmen's transition to college life as smooth and enjoyable as possible while also integrating our incoming students and their families into the Langston University community. Students who attend Lion Camp get a first-hand experience of life on a college campus.
- Your Lion Camp experience will be jammed packed with team building activities, pride group competitions, college preparedness programs, social programs, and much more. We welcome you to your new home on the hill.

Is Lion Camp mandatory?

- Lion Camp is not mandatory, but it is **highly recommended**. Approximately 95% of our incoming freshman class attends Lion Camp. It's at Lion Camp where you will learn about campus life, student services, and get a chance to meet some of your new classmates.

How do I register for Lion Camp?

- Students who are enrolled in the one week Personal, Social and Development (PSD) for the intercession period of July 27th-31st is registered for Lion Camp. Nothing else is required outside of you making a move-in appointment with Residential Life and Housing Services to move in July 24th-July 26th.

What is the structure of Lion Camp?

- Move-in weekend will host social programs and the academic orientation for your course that begins on Monday morning. Monday through Friday will essentially follow this format: 9am-12pm class, 1pm-5pm Mandatory Sessions, 7pm-9pm social events and the last weekend will host some additional programming culminating with our Freshmen Class Induction and Cookout.

How much does Lion Camp cost?

- Students who participate in Lion Camp will be charged a \$250 orientation fee on their fall semester bursar account. The student will also be assessed a \$175 Lion Camp Meal plan that will cover their meals during Lion Camp. That fee will also be charged to their fall semester bursar account.

What time do I need to arrive?

- You may move in on Friday, July 24th from 8am to 4pm, Saturday, July 25th from 8am to 4pm and Sunday, July 26th from 8am to 11:30am. If you have made an appointment with Housing, you will be eligible to move in.

What do I need to bring to Lion Camp?

Does my parent or guardian need to attend Lion Camp?

- We recommend your parents and family come to assist you in moving in. After you are all moved in, your parents are free to go, because your Lion Camp experience has begun. We will offer a parent information session on Friday, July 24th, Saturday, July 25th and Sunday, July 26th for campus officials to meet with parents and address all questions that you may have about Langston University.

Where will I stay during Lion Camp?

- You will move into your assigned housing space and will remain in that space for the duration of Lion Camp and the Fall 2026 semester.

What dining options are available during Lion Camp?

- Our cafeteria opens for Dinner on Friday, July 24th. Brunch and Dinner are served on Saturday and Sunday and Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner are served Monday through Friday.

How will Lion Camp work for students who are attending Band Camp?

- Band students are enrolled in the University Band freshman course (MS 2611); however, they will participate in mandatory afternoon sessions. We coordinate with Professor Gordon to ensure that the band students are in the appropriate sessions.
